<p>Aims / Subspecialist Areas of Interest:</p> <p>On the completion of the program fellows will be comfortable with all aspects of aesthetic breast surgery including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fellows will become an integral part of the multi-disciplinary team and need to collaborate with all team members including anaesthetists, nursing staff, psychologists, and administrative staff.• They will develop a deeper understanding of the psychological aspects of aesthetic breast surgery and work closely with the BA psychology team to identify at risk individuals pre-operatively including those with BDD and other anxiety disorders that impact on the consent process.• Anaesthetists with extensive experience in managing aesthetic surgery patients will provide guidance on managing pain in patients undergoing aesthetic breast surgery with a particular focus on the use of regional anaesthesia and post-operative analgesia.• Experienced perioperative nursing staff will provide guidance on surgical equipment, theatre setup and operating list flow.
